

Homework Policies:

Concerned with the total development of the child, we as a faculty see a benefit to homework, both as a reinforcement of what was taught during the day and as a chance to have the child attempt and succeed in work, independently of the classroom teacher.

Homework is given at all grade levels, with increased expectations as the students progress through the grades.

Homework on weekends is discouraged but studying for tests and working on long-term projects is a good use of weekend time.

If your child is spending an inordinate amount of time on homework, please be sure to consult with his/her teacher to try to resolve the problem.
