

Traditions at St. Bernadette

School Mass is held each month. Grades one through eight take turns preparing the monthly Mass. Parents are welcome to attend.

Color Days are held approximately once a month. The students may wear school colors (blue and white) for \$1.00 or any color clothing for \$2.00. The proceeds are donated to a worthy cause.
